Impressive lineup of judges announced for Wine Australia China Awards 2019

(Shanghai, 2 August 2019) — Today, Wine Australia announced its panel of esteemed judges for the seventh annual China Awards.

The Wine Australia China Awards 2019, to be held in Shanghai on 11 November, is the preeminent event in the wine sector, which recognises those who have made outstanding contributions to promoting and raising the awareness of Australian wine in China.

The diverse judging panel consists of 14 high-profile wine sector professionals. Among the esteemed group is Master Sommelier Lu Yang, who will serve as the panel leader of the four media awards, and Ms Stella Cai, Senior Business Development Manager at Australian Trade and Investment Commission Shanghai, who will serve as the panel leader of the four trade awards.

This year, for the first time, Wine Australia will host a judging day, where the judges will determine the winners of each award category.
