

Proposing and Seconding Candidates

- 1. Candidates for election may not propose or second themselves (personally). If they are the Corporate Voting Member Representative of an AustCham Shanghai Corporate Member company, they may propose and second others. Each candidate agrees to sign and abide by the Director's Code of Conduct, undertaking to fulfil the related responsibilities if elected.
- 2. The signatures of a proposer and seconder to the nomination are registered representatives of Voting Member Representatives of AustCham Shanghai Corporate Members. All signatures must be on a single candidate nomination form.
- 3. Candidates who are not the registered Voting Member Representative of their Employer Company must be proposed by the Voting Member representative of their Employer Company (Refer points above and the accompanying candidate Nomination Form to be completed in full as requested).
- 4. A Voting Member Representative may propose or second more than one candidate for election, provided each candidate nominated is employed by a different AustCham Shanghai Corporate Member.
- 5. Details of proposers and seconders shall be stated on the election materials made available for voters.
