ABOUT AUSTCHAM SHANGHAI

The Australian Chamber of Commerce Shanghai (AustCham Shanghai) is the peak body for Australian business in East China. As a membership-based organisation, AustCham Shanghai represents businesses and individuals involved in trade and investment between Australia and China and provides support, education, advocacy and business services.

Founded in 1994, AustCham Shanghai is the largest Australian Chamber of Commerce in Greater China. As the trading relationship has evolved beyond energy and resources to encapsulate a wide variety of sectors, AustCham Shanghai has grown to represent businesses in every sector, from manufacturing, food and beverage, health and aged care, to education, and financial services.

The Chamber is based at Australia House by AustCham Shanghai, a standalone 5,300sqm seven-storey building in downtown Shanghai that provides physical offices, co-working spaces, food and beverage outlets, event spaces and showcase opportunities for the Australia-China business community. The development is in partnership with Anken, a long-term member of the Chamber.

Today, our Chamber brings the business community together through membership services, events, delegations, project management, representation and advocacy.

NETWORKS

Facilitated Business Connections

AustCham Shanghai provides members a number of channels to connect with fellow member companies and grow their in market network. AustCham Shanghai's Miniprogram, powered by UMS, is an online platform where members are able to scroll through the full membership directory and submit direct enquiries for potential connections. AustCham Shanghai's Relationship Managers also work directly with members throughout the year on bespoke plans, which include direct connections to relevant partners and businesses.

Industry Forums

AustCham Shanghai currently has seven industry forums including: Finance, Investment & Tax; HR; Food, Beverage & Agribusiness; Manufacturing, Sourcing & Supply Chain; Built Environment; Education & Training; Women in Business. These industry forums provide platforms for members in relevant sectors to grow their network with decision makers and share insights. Industry forum activities take place quarterly and range from exclusive lunches to roundtable briefings. Our industry forums are additionally chaired by volunteer members who are able to further cater highly relevant activities for industry members.

Insights Promotion


